

Electoral signage on SA Power Networks infrastructure – election materials - indemnity

Dear applicant,

Political advertising related to State, Commonwealth and local Government elections is permitted on SA Power Networks' Stobie poles and public lighting poles, subject to compliance with relevant legislative and council requirements (including but not limited to, the Electoral Act 1985 and the Local Government Act 1999), and the requirements in [NICC 210 - Signage Banners and Temporary Equipment on SA Power Networks Assets](#)

- No ladders or plant are to be leant against the light columns during installation or removal works (any ladders used must be a self-supporting type only).
- No damage is to be caused to any poles or equipment mounted on the poles.
- Election material shall not conceal or obstruct any signs, identification numbers or any major SA Power Networks equipment mounted on the poles.
- SA Power Networks does not accept any liability for replacing the election materials on the poles when these are repaired or replaced in the normal course of system operating requirements.
- The applicant agrees to indemnify SA Power Networks against any costs and losses it incurs relating to the placement of the election materials on the columns,
- The applicant takes full responsibility for all safety considerations related to the election material on the poles and must ensure suitable job safe work methods are used and site by site risk assessments are undertaken.
