

## SA Power Networks – Office Sharing Register

Class of Office	Exemption	Justification
<b>SA Power Networks Head Office</b>	4.2.1 (b) i. a.	Enerven support functions (Safety, Environment, HR) from time-to-time may be co-located alongside SA Power Networks counterparts in SA Power Networks head office. These staff do not have access to electricity information.
<b>Enerven Head Office</b>	Not required	Enerven head office is a separate physical location from SA Power Networks head office, therefore no exemption from the requirements is necessary. From time-to-time, SA Power Networks corporate staff may be located at Enerven Head Office.
<b>Inner Metropolitan Depots</b>	4.2.1 (b) i. b. 4.2.1 (b) iii.	Inner Metropolitan Depots contain a mixture of SA Power Networks and Enerven staff. These Enerven staff predominately perform Other Non-Electricity Services, however may be called upon to assist with SA Power Networks regulated works (e.g. Emergency Response). These staff have access to electricity information where required to perform work for SA Power Networks, but do not have any opportunity in their role to use the information to engage in conduct that is contrary to the guideline. They also receive appropriate training in information sharing and usage.
<b>Outer Metropolitan Depots</b>	4.2.1 (b) i. b. 4.2.1 (b) iii.	Outer Metropolitan Depots contain a mixture of SA Power Networks and Enerven staff. These Enerven staff predominately perform Other Non-Electricity Services, however may be called upon to assist with SA Power Networks regulated works (e.g. Emergency Response). These staff have access to electricity information where required to perform work for SA Power Networks, but do not have any opportunity in their role to use the information to engage in conduct that is contrary to the guideline. They also receive appropriate training in information sharing and usage.
<b>Country Depots</b>	4.2.1 (b) i. b. 4.2.1 (b) iii.	A portion of SA Power Networks country depots have Enerven staff present. These Enerven staff predominately perform Other Non-Electricity Services, however may be called upon to assist with SA Power Networks regulated works (e.g. Emergency Response). These staff have access to electricity information where required to perform work for SA Power Networks, but do not have any opportunity in their role to use the information to engage in conduct that is contrary to the guideline. They also receive appropriate training in information sharing and usage.

## SA Power Networks – Staff Sharing Register

The following are staff positions that are shared; that is, they may work in the provision of both direct control services and contestable electricity services provided by ourselves or a related electricity service provider.

<b>Electrical Technician / Technical Officer</b>	Responsible for the construction, repair and maintenance of power supply and telecommunications components.
